

**MATTHEW**  
**Chapter 19**

*Note: The number of the question is the actual verse number*

- 1a When Jesus had finished His sayings, where did He depart from?  
– *Galilee*
- 1b Where did Jesus come to after departing from Galilee?  
– *to the region of Judea beyond the Jordan*
- 2a Who followed Jesus to Judea?  
– *great multitudes*
- 2b What did Jesus do for the multitudes?  
– *he healed them there*
- 3a Who also came to Him along with the multitudes?  
– *the Pharisees*
- 3b What did the Pharisees want to do to Jesus?  
– *they were testing Him*
- 3c What did the Pharisees ask Jesus about divorce?  
– *“Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife for just any reason?”*
- 4a Where did Jesus ask them if they got their information?  
– *“Have you not read...?”*
- 4b What did Jesus answer them about what He who made them at the beginning made them?  
– *He made them male and female*
- 5a Who did Jesus say a man should leave?  
– *his father and mother*
- 5b After leaving his father and mother, who did Jesus say a man should be joined to?  
– *his wife*
- 5c What did Jesus say a man and his wife shall become?  
– *one flesh*
- 6a If a man and his wife are no longer two, but one flesh, who has joined them together?  
– *God*
- 6b What should man do, or not do, to that which God has joined together?  
– *let not man separate*
- 7 What did the Pharisees say Moses had said they could do to divorce their wives?  
– *Moses had commanded to give a certificate of divorce and to put her away*
- 8a What did Jesus say was the reason Moses had permitted them to divorce their wives?  
– *because of the hardness of their hearts*
- 8b Did Jesus say God had allowed divorce from the beginning?  
– *from the beginning it was not so*
- 9a What was the only reason Jesus said that a person could divorce his wife?  
– *for sexual immorality*

- 9b What did Jesus say a person does if they divorce their wife and marry another, (except for sexual immorality)?  
 – *he commits adultery*
- 9c Whoever marries her who is divorced, does what?  
 – *commits adultery*
- 10 What did Jesus’ disciples think about what Jesus taught on divorce?  
 – *they said, “If such is the case of the man with his wife, it is better not to marry”*
- 11a Did Jesus say everyone could accept His teaching?  
 – *no, “all cannot accept this saying”*
- 11b Who did Jesus say could accept His teaching?  
 – *only those to whom it has been given*
- 12a What are the 3 types of eunuchs Jesus mentioned?  
 – *1) there are eunuchs who were born thus from their mother’s womb, 2) there are eunuchs who were made eunuchs by men, and 3) there are eunuchs who have made themselves eunuchs for the kingdom of heaven’s sake*
- 12b Who did Jesus say should accept being a eunuch?  
 – *he who is able*
- 13a Why were little children brought to Jesus?  
 – *that He might put His hands on them and pray*
- 13b What did the disciples do to those who brought the little children?  
 – *they rebuked them*
- 14 What did Jesus say about the little children coming to Him?  
 – *“Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of heaven”*
- 15a What did Jesus do to the little children?  
 – *He laid His hands on them*
- 15b What did Jesus do after laying hands on the little children?  
 – *He departed from there*
- 16 What did one (whom we call the Rich Young Ruler) come and say to Jesus?  
 – *“Good Teacher, what good thing shall I do that I may have eternal life?”*
- 17a What did Jesus reply about the young man saying he was a Good Teacher?  
 – *“Why do you call Me good?”*
- 17b Who did Jesus say is good?  
 – *“No one is good but One, that is, God”*
- 17c What did Jesus say the young man should do if he wanted to enter into life?  
 – *keep the commandments*
- 18a What did the young man reply when Jesus said to keep the commandments?  
 – *“Which ones?”*
- 18-19 What 6 commandments did Jesus list in His reply to the young man as to which ones to keep?  
 – *1) You shall not murder, 2) You shall not commit adultery, 3) You shall not steal, 4) You shall not bear false witness, 5) Honor your father and your mother, and 6) You shall love your neighbor as yourself*

- 20 What did the young man say in reply after Jesus listed several commandments to keep?  
– *“All these things I have kept from my youth. What do I still lack?”*
- 21 What did Jesus tell the young man he should do if he wanted to be perfect? “Go, \_\_\_\_\_  
what you have and \_\_\_\_\_ to the \_\_\_\_\_ and you will have \_\_\_\_\_ in heaven; and  
\_\_\_\_\_, follow me.”  
– *sell, give, poor, treasure, come*
- 22a What did the young man do when he heard what Jesus about selling his stuff?  
– *he went away sorrowful*
- 22b Why did the young man go away from Jesus sorrowfully?  
– *for he had great possessions*
- 23 Who did Jesus say it was hard for to enter the kingdom of heaven?  
– *a rich man*
- 24 Complete: “And again I say to \_\_\_\_\_, it is easier for a \_\_\_\_\_ to go through the  
\_\_\_\_\_ of a \_\_\_\_\_ than for a \_\_\_\_\_ man to enter the \_\_\_\_\_ of God”  
– *you, camel, eye, needle, rich, kingdom*
- 25a When the disciples heard what Jesus said about how hard it is for a rich man to enter heaven,  
how did they feel?  
– *they were greatly astonished*
- 25b What did the disciples say about Jesus teaching regarding rich men?  
– *“Who then can be saved?”*
- 26a What did Jesus do when He replied to the disciples question?  
– *He looked at them*
- 26b What did Jesus reply to the disciples’ question about who could be saved?  
– *“With men this is impossible, but with God, all things are possible”*
- 27a Who said, “See, we have left all and followed You.”?  
– *Peter*
- 27b What did Peter want to know, since they had left all and followed Jesus?  
– *“Therefore, what shall we have?”*
- 28a What is the “regeneration”?  
– *when the Son of Man sits on the throne of His glory*
- 28b What did Jesus tell them that those who had followed Him would receive in the regeneration,  
when He sits on His throne?  
– *they would also sit on twelve thrones*
- 28c What would the disciples do when they sat on their twelve thrones?  
– *they would judge the twelve tribes of Israel*
- 29a What 8 things did Jesus list that people had left to follow Him?  
– *1) houses, 2) brothers, 3) sisters, 4) father, 5) mother, 6) wife, 7) children, or 8)  
lands*
- 29b Why had people left all these things?  
– *“for My name’s sake”*
- 29c What 2 things would be the reward for leaving all to follow Christ?  
– *1) they shall receive a hundredfold, and 2) inherit eternal life*
- 30 Complete: “But \_\_\_\_\_ who are \_\_\_\_\_ will be \_\_\_\_\_, and the \_\_\_\_\_

\_\_\_\_\_.”

– *many, first, last, last, first*
