

## 1 Corinthians 5

### Immorality Defiles the Church

1 It is actually reported that there is \_\_\_\_\_ among you, and such sexual immorality as is not even named[l] among the \_\_\_\_\_—that a man has his father's \_\_\_\_\_! 2 And you are puffed up, and have not rather \_\_\_\_\_, that he who has done this deed might be taken away from among you. 3 For I indeed, as \_\_\_\_\_ in body but \_\_\_\_\_ in spirit, have already judged (as though I were present) him who has so done this deed. 4 In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, when you are \_\_\_\_\_ together, along with my spirit, with the \_\_\_\_\_ of our Lord Jesus Christ, 5 deliver such a one to \_\_\_\_\_ for the \_\_\_\_\_ of the flesh, that his spirit may be \_\_\_\_\_ in the \_\_\_\_\_ of the Lord Jesus.[m]

6 Your \_\_\_\_\_ is not good. Do you not know that a little \_\_\_\_\_ leavens the whole \_\_\_\_\_? 7 Therefore \_\_\_\_\_ out the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, since you truly are \_\_\_\_\_. ### Immorality Must Be Judged

9 I wrote to you in my epistle not to keep company with \_\_\_\_\_ people. 10 Yet I certainly did not mean with the sexually immoral people of this \_\_\_\_\_, or with the \_\_\_\_\_, or \_\_\_\_\_, or \_\_\_\_\_, since then you would need to go out of the world. 11 But now I have written to you not to keep company with anyone named a \_\_\_\_\_, who is sexually immoral, or covetous, or an idolater, or a \_\_\_\_\_, or a \_\_\_\_\_, or an extortioner—not even to \_\_\_\_\_ with such a person.

12 For what have I to do with \_\_\_\_\_ those also who are \_\_\_\_\_? Do you not judge those who are inside? 13 But those who are outside \_\_\_\_\_ judges. Therefore “put away from yourselves the evil \_\_\_\_\_.”
