Pray for us

Faith

1. Run swiftly
2. Be glorified

Faithful

The word of the Lord

(1) Establish you and
(2) guard you from the evil one

As it is with you
(the brethren)

The evil one

1. That the word of the Lord may run swiftly and be glorified (vs. 1)
2. That we (PST) may be delivered from unreasonable and wicked men (vs. 2).

In the name of our Lord
Jesus Christ

Both (1) do and (2) will do
the things we command
you

1. Disorderly
2. Not according to the tradition
which he received from us

Confidence in the Lord

The tradition which he
received from us

1. Into the love of God
2. Into the patience of Christ

How you ought to follow
us (PST)

Direct them

Disorderly

Withdraw from every brother
who walks disorderly and not
according to the tradition
which he received from us

Authority

Anyone's bread free of
charge

How you (the brethren)
should follow us

With (1) labor and toil
(2) night and day

"If anyone will not work,
neither shall he eat."

1. That we might not be a burden to any of you (vs. 8)
2. To make ourselves an example of how you should follow us (vs. 9)

Eat

1. Labor
2. Toil

- (1) They walk among you in a disorderly manner,
- (2) Not working at all
- (3) They are busybodies

(1) Night and (2) Day

He will be ashamed

1. Work in quietness
2. Eat their own bread

Enemy

Through our Lord Jesus
Christ

Admonish him as a brother
(vs. 14--note him and not
keep company with him)

Good

1. May the Lord of peace
Himself give you peace always
in every way.
2. The Lord be with you all.

Grow weary in doing
good

Always in every way

- (1) Note that person and
- (2) do not keep company
with him
