 - When it was evening
- What 2 reasons did the disciples give for sending the crowds away to get food?
 - -1) it was a deserted place, and 2) the hour was already late
- Jesus said the people did not have to go away. Then He commanded the disciples to do what?
 - "You give them something to eat."

 - five loaves and two fish
- What did Jesus tell the disciples to do with the loaves and fish?
 - "Bring them here to Me."

 - on the grass
- What did Jesus do with the five loaves and two fish?
 - looking up to heaven, He blessed and broke and gave the loaves to the disciples
- After all ate and were filled, how much remained of the fragments?
 - twelve baskets full
- 21 How many were fed with the five loaves and two fish?
 - about five thousand men, besides women and children
- What did Jesus have the disciples do while He sent the multitudes away?
 - get into the boat and go before Him to the other side
- When did Jesus ask the disciples to get into the boat?
 - immediately
- Where did Jesus go to pray after dismissing the multitudes?
 - up on the mountain
- When was Jesus alone on the mountain praying?
 - when evening came
- While the Jesus was on the mountain in the evening, where was the boats the disciples were
- in?
- in the middle of the sea
- 24b Why was the disciples' boat being tossed by the waves?
 - the wind was contrary
- 25 When did Jesus walk on the sea to the disciples?

	– in the fourth watch of the night

27	Jesus said, "Be of! It is I; do not be"
	– good cheer, afraid
28a	Who answered Jesus when He identified Himself on the water?
	– Peter
28b	Peter asked Jesus to command him to do what?
	– come to Him on the water
29a	What was Jesus' response to Peter's request?
	- "Come"
29b	What did Peter do after coming down out of the boat?
	– he walked on the water to go to Jesus
30a	When Peter was walking on the water, the wind was
	– boisterous
30b	How did Peter feel when he realized how boisterous the wind was?
	– he was afraid
30c	When did Peter cry out, "Lord, save me!"
	as he was "beginning to sink"
31a	What did Jesus do in response to Peter's cry for help?
	– He immediately stretched out His hand and caught him
31b	"O you of, why did you doubt?"
	– little faith
32	What happened when Jesus and Peter got into the boat?
	– the wind ceased
33	What did those in the boat do and say after the wind ceased?
	- worshiped Him, saying, "Truly You are the Son of God."
34	Where did Jesus and the disciples come to shore after the storm ceased?
	– the land of Gennesaret
35	Who recognized Jesus and brought to Him all who were sick in the surrounding region?
	- "the men of that place"
36a	What did those who were sick beg Jesus?
	– that they might only touch the hem of His garment
36b	In the region of Gennesaret, who were made perfectly well?
	- as many as touched the hem of Jesus garment
