– *Herod the tetrarch*
- 2a Who did Herod think Jesus was?
– *John the Baptist risen from the dead*
- 2b What did Herod think was at work in Jesus because He might be John, raised from the dead?
– *these powers (to do the miracles)*
- 3a What 3 things had Herod done to John the Baptist?
– *1) laid hold of him, 2) bound him, 3) put him in prison*
- 3b Why had Herod imprisoned John the Baptist?
– *for the sake of Herodias*
- 3b Who was Herodias?
– *the wife of Herod's brother, Philip*
- 4 John had said to him, "It is not _____ for you to have her."
– *lawful*
- 5a What did Herod want to do with John?
– *put him to death*
- 5b Why did Herod not kill John?
– *he feared the multitude, because they counted him as a prophet*
- 6 Who danced at Herod's birthday celebration?
– *the daughter of Herodias*
- 7a How did Herod promise to give the daughter of Herodias whatever she might ask?
– *with an oath*
- 7b Why did Herod promise to give the daughter of Herodias whatever she might ask?
– *because she pleased him*
- 8 Being prompted by her mother, what did Herodias' daughter ask of Herod to give her?
– *"Give me John the Baptist's head here on a platter"*
- 9a How did Herod feel upon hearing the request to have John killed?
– *he was sorry*
- 9b For what 2 reasons did Herod go ahead and order John's execution?
– *1) because of the oaths and 2) because of those who sat with him*
- 10 Where was John beheaded?
– *in the prison*
- 11 What 3 things were done with John's head after his execution?
– *1) brought on a platter, 2) given to the girl, and 3) she brought it to her mother*
- 12a Who took John's body away and buried it?
– *his disciples*
- 12b How was Jesus informed about the death of John?
– *John's disciples went and told Jesus*

- 13a When Jesus heard about the death of John, what did He do?
– *“He departed from there by boat to a deserted place by Himself”*
- 13b The multitudes heard about where Jesus had gone by Himself, and they followed Him from where?
– *the cities*
- 13c How did the multitudes that followed after Jesus travel?
– *on foot*
- 14 How did Jesus respond to seeing the great multitude after His time alone? (two points)
– *1) He was moved with compassion for them, and 2) healed their sick*
- 15a When did the disciples suggest that Jesus send the multitudes away to buy food for themselves?
– *When it was evening*
- 15b What 2 reasons did the disciples give for sending the crowds away to get food?
– *1) it was a deserted place, and 2) the hour was already late*
- 16 Jesus said the people did not have to go away. Then He commanded the disciples to do what?
– *“You give them something to eat.”*
- 17 How much food did the disciples have available with which to feed the multitude?
– *five loaves and two fish*
- 18 What did Jesus tell the disciples to do with the loaves and fish?
– *“Bring them here to Me.”*
- 19a Where did Jesus tell the multitudes to sit down before being fed?
– *on the grass*
- 19b What did Jesus do with the five loaves and two fish?
– *looking up to heaven, He blessed and broke and gave the loaves to the disciples*
- 20 After all ate and were filled, how much remained of the fragments?
– *twelve baskets full*
- 21 How many were fed with the five loaves and two fish?
– *about five thousand men, besides women and children*
- 22a What did Jesus have the disciples do while He sent the multitudes away?
– *get into the boat and go before Him to the other side*
- 22b When did Jesus ask the disciples to get into the boat?
– *immediately*
- 23a Where did Jesus go to pray after dismissing the multitudes?
– *up on the mountain*
- 23b When was Jesus alone on the mountain praying?
– *when evening came*
- 24a While the Jesus was on the mountain in the evening, where was the boats the disciples were in?
– *in the middle of the sea*
- 24b Why was the disciples’ boat being tossed by the waves?
– *the wind was contrary*
- 25 When did Jesus walk on the sea to the disciples?

- in the fourth watch of the night*
- 26 What was the reaction of the disciples to seeing Jesus walking on the water? (3 points)
– “they were troubled, saying, ‘It is a ghost!’ And they cried out for fear”
- 27 Jesus said, “Be of _____! It is I; do not be _____.”
– good cheer, afraid
- 28a Who answered Jesus when He identified Himself on the water?
– Peter
- 28b Peter asked Jesus to command him to do what?
– come to Him on the water
- 29a What was Jesus’ response to Peter’s request?
– “Come”
- 29b What did Peter do after coming down out of the boat?
– he walked on the water to go to Jesus
- 30a When Peter was walking on the water, the wind was _____.
– boisterous
- 30b How did Peter feel when he realized how boisterous the wind was?
– he was afraid
- 30c When did Peter cry out, “Lord, save me!”
– as he was “beginning to sink”
- 31a What did Jesus do in response to Peter’s cry for help?
– He immediately stretched out His hand and caught him
- 31b “O you of _____, why did you doubt?”
– little faith
- 32 What happened when Jesus and Peter got into the boat?
– the wind ceased
- 33 What did those in the boat do and say after the wind ceased?
– worshiped Him, saying, “Truly You are the Son of God.”
- 34 Where did Jesus and the disciples come to shore after the storm ceased?
– the land of Gennesaret
- 35 Who recognized Jesus and brought to Him all who were sick in the surrounding region?
– “the men of that place”
- 36a What did those who were sick beg Jesus?
– that they might only touch the hem of His garment
- 36b In the region of Gennesaret, who were made perfectly well?
– as many as touched the hem of Jesus garment
