Pathfinder Bible Achievement History

1987 - 1988: Pathfinder Bible Achievement began as the Pathfinder Bible Bowl with the first event held in Wyoming in 1988. The program was developed by Elder Terry Dodge, who was pastor of the Sheridan, Wyoming Seventh-Day Adventist church.

1989 – 1990: Elder Dodge led in expanding the Pathfinder Bible Bowl to the entire Rocky Mountain Conference.

1991 -1993: In 1990 Elder Dodge moved to Michigan and became the Conference Pathfinder Director and introduced Pathfinder Bible Bowl to the Michigan Conference.

1993 - 2003: In 1993 the program was adopted in the North American Division with Area Level and Conference Level events in many conferences. In 1996 the Union Level events were added and the North American Division Level was first held in April 2000.

2003 - : The name was changed to Pathfinder Bible Achievement and new guidelines were created.

2008 Pathfinder Bible Achievement

The material covered in the 2008 Bible Achievement is The Gospel According to Matthew (New King James Version) and the Introduction to The Gospel According to St. Matthew in the SDA Bible Commentary.

In Bible Achievement all teams can win a first place. Teams that score 90% or better of the score of the top scoring team receives a First place in the competition. (For example, if the team with the highest score was 100 points out of 110 possible points, any team that scored 90 points or more would get a first place.) This makes Bible Achievement more of a test of what each team has learned than a competition against other teams.
