But if it is shameful for a woman to be shorn or shaved, let her be _____. 7 For a man indeed ought not to _____ his head, since he is the _____ and _____ of God; but _____ is the glory of man. 8 For man is not from woman, but woman from man. 9 Nor was man created for the woman, but woman for the man. 10 For this reason the woman ought to have a symbol of _____ on her head, because of the _____. 11 Nevertheless, neither is man _____ of woman, nor woman _____ of man, in the Lord. 12 For as woman came from man, even so man also comes _____ woman; but _____ are from God.

13 Judge among yourselves. Is it proper for a woman to pray to God with her head uncovered? 14 Does not even nature itself teach you that if a man has _____, it is a dishonor to him? 15 But if a woman has long hair, it is a _____ to her; for her hair is given to her for a _____. 16 But if anyone seems to be _____, we have no such custom, nor do the churches of God.

23 For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the same night in which He was _____ took bread; 24 and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "Take, eat; this is My _____ which is _____ for you; do this in remembrance of Me." 25 In the same manner He also took the cup after _____, saying, "This cup is the new _____ in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in _____ of Me."

26 For as often as you eat this _____ and _____ this cup, you proclaim the Lord's _____ till He comes. Examine Yourself

27 Therefore whoever _____ this bread or _____ this cup of the Lord in an _____ will be guilty of the body and blood[al] of the Lord. 28 But let a man _____ himself, and so let him eat of the bread and drink of the cup. 29 For he who eats and drinks in an unworthy manner eats and drinks _____ to himself, not discerning the Lord's _____. 30 For this reason many are _____ and _____ among you, and many _____. 31 For if we would judge ourselves, we would not be judged. 32 But when we are judged, we are _____ by the Lord, that we may not be _____ with the world. 33 Therefore, my brethren, when you come together to eat, wait for one another. 34 But if anyone is hungry, let him eat at _____, lest you come together for judgment. And the rest I will set in _____ when I come.
