

## MATTHEW Chapter 11

*Note: The number of the question is the actual verse number*

- 1 When Jesus finished commanding His twelve disciples, what did He do?  
– *He departed from there to teach and to preach in their cities.*
- 2 Who heard from prison about the works of Christ?  
– *John the Baptist*
- 3 What question did John the Baptist send through two of his disciples?  
– *“Are You the Coming One, or do we look for another?”*
- 4 Complete: “Go and tell \_\_\_\_\_ the things which you \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_.”  
– *John, hear, see*
- 5 What 6 things did Jesus say to tell John the Baptist about?  
– *1) the blind see, 2) the lame walk, 3) the lepers are cleansed, 4) the deaf hear, 5) the dead are raised, 6) the poor have the gospel preached to them*
- 6 Before John’s disciples left, who did Jesus say was blessed?  
– *“he who is not offended because of Me.”*
- 7 Complete: “What did you go out into the \_\_\_\_\_ to see? A \_\_\_\_\_ shaken by the \_\_\_\_\_?”  
– *wilderness, reed, wind*
- 7-9 What are the 3 things Jesus asked the people that they went out to see (concerning John)?  
– *1) a reed shaken by the wind, 2) a man clothed in soft garments, 3) a prophet*
- 9 Did Jesus say John was a prophet?  
– *“Yes...and more than a prophet”*
- 10 What is the prophecy concerning John?  
– *“Behold, I send My messenger before Your face, who will prepare Your way before You”*
- 11a No one has been born greater than who?  
– *John the Baptist*
- 11b Complete: “Assuredly, I say to you, among those \_\_\_\_\_ there has  
not risen one greater than John the Baptist;”  
– *born of women*
- 11c Who is greater than John the Baptist?  
– *“he who is least in the kingdom of heaven”*
- 12 From the time of John the Baptist’s ministry until when Jesus was teaching the multitudes, He said that the kingdom of heaven suffered what?  
– *violence, and the violent take it by force*
- 13 Who and what prophesied until John?  
– *1) all the prophets and 2) the law*
- 14 Complete: “And if you are willing to receive it, he is \_\_\_\_\_ who is to come.”  
– *Elijah*
- 15 Complete: “He who has ears to hear, \_\_\_\_\_!”  
– *let him hear*
- 16 To what did Jesus liken his generation?

- *“Like children sitting in the marketplaces and calling to their companions”*
- 17 Complete: “We played the \_\_\_\_\_ for you, and you did not \_\_\_\_\_; We \_\_\_\_\_ to you, and you did not \_\_\_\_\_.”  
– *flute, dance, mourned, lament*
- 18 What did some accuse John the Baptist of because he came neither eating or drinking?  
– *“He has a demon”*
- 19a What 3 things did some accuse Jesus of being because he came eating and drinking?  
– *1) a glutton, 2) a winebibber, 3) a friend of tax collectors and sinners*
- 19b By what is wisdom justified?  
– *her children*
- 20a Then Jesus began to rebuke the cities in which what had been done?  
– *most of His mighty works*
- 20b Why did Jesus rebuke the cities?  
– *because they did not repent*
- 21-23 Jesus pronounced rebukes on what 3 Jewish cities?  
– *1) Chorazin, 2) Bethsaida, 3) Capernaum*
- 21-23 These Jewish cities were compared to what 3 Gentile cities?  
– *1) Tyre, 2) Sidon, 3) Sodom*
- 21 If the works of Jesus had been performed in Tyre and Sidon, how would they have repented?  
– *in sackcloth and ashes*
- 22 Complete: “But I say to you, it will be more tolerable for \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ in the \_\_\_\_\_.”  
– *Tyre, Sidon, day, of, judgment*
- 23 What city exalted to heaven would be brought down to Hades?  
– *Capernaum*
- 24 Complete: “...it shall be more \_\_\_\_\_ for the land of \_\_\_\_\_ in the day of judgment than for \_\_\_\_\_.”  
– *tolerable, Sodom, you*
- 25 Jesus thanked the Father for hiding these things from who, and revealing them to who?  
– *1) the wise and prudent, 2) babes*
- 26 Complete: “Even so, \_\_\_\_\_, for so it seemed \_\_\_\_\_ in Your \_\_\_\_\_.”  
– *Father, good, sight*
- 27a What had been delivered to Jesus by His Father?  
– *“all things”*
- 27b Who knows the Son?  
– *only the Father*
- 27c Who knows the Father?  
– *“only the Son, and the one to whom the Son wills to reveal Him.”*
- 28-30 Quote Matthew 11:28-30:  
– *“Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.”*
