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ANS: ninth (9th) year and tenth (10th) month

3 points. According to Jeremiah 39:2, in what year, month, and day of Zedekiah was the city penetrated by the Babylonians?



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ANS: eleventh (11th) year, fourth (4th) month, on the ninth (9th) day

6 points. According to Jeremiah 39:3, what six names are given as princes of Babylon who came and sat in the Middle Gate?



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ANS: Nergal-Sharezer, Samgar-Nebo, Sarsechim, Rabsaris, Nergal-Sarezer, Rabmag

(note the footnote says that Rabsaris and Rabmag were not names, but titles, and the commentary says Sagmar-Nebo was also not a name but a place)

ANS: fled (and went out of the city by night)

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ANS: king's garden, gate between the two walls, way of the plain

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ANS: plains of Jericho

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ANS: Riblah in the land of Hamath

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ANS: Zedekiah's sons and all the nobles of Judah

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ANS: put out his eyes and bound him with bronze fetters
