**In Hebrew:** Egypt, Philistia, Moab, Ammon, Edom, Damascus, Kedar and Hazor, Elam, and Babylon:

In Hebrew prophecies are found in chs 46 to 51, LXX are found in 25:14 to 31:44.

Tahpanhes, Egypt

**In LXX:** Elam, Egypt, Babylon, Philistia, Edom, Ammon, Kedar and Hazor, Damascus, and Moab.

Several texts do not appear, or there are minor variation with phrases and single words.

“saith the LORD,” “the prophet,” “the king,” the God of Israel,” or “the God of host.”

The LXX is about 1/8<sup>th</sup> or 2,700 words shorter than the Hebrew.

When the Hebrew was translated to LXX it was deliberately shortened.

Palestine and Egypt

The theory of double recension of the book of Jeremiah.

Jeremiah 8:10b-12 was omitted in the LXX. It is similar to Jeremiah 6:12-15.

The LXX was deliberately shortened

Omitting repetitions, simplifying the style, abbreviating difficult readings.
