### Chapter 26

*Note: The number of the question is the actual verse number*

- 1 When Jesus finished these sayings (from previous chapter), who did He talk to?  
– *His disciples*
- 2a How many days after this time was the Passover?  
– *two days*
- 2b “The \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_ will be delivered up to be \_\_\_\_\_.”  
– *Son, Man, crucified*
- 3a What 3 groups had assembled at the palace of the High Priest?  
– *chief priests, the scribes, and the elders*
- 3b Who was the High Priest?  
– *Caiaphas*
- 4 What 2 things did they plot to do?  
– *1) to take Jesus by trickery and 2) kill Him*
- 5 But they said, “Not during the \_\_\_\_\_, lest there be an \_\_\_\_\_ among the \_\_\_\_\_.”  
– *feast, uproar, people*
- 6 When Jesus was at Bethany, whose house did He stay at?  
– *Simon the leper*
- 7a “A \_\_\_\_\_ came to Him having an \_\_\_\_\_ of very \_\_\_\_\_  
\_\_\_\_\_ oil”  
– *woman, alabaster, flask, costly, fragrant*
- 7b She poured it on Jesus’ head as He did what?  
– *sat at the table*
- 8a But when Jesus’ disciples saw her do this, how did they feel?  
– *indignant*
- 8b What did they say about the woman with the perfume?  
– *“Why this waste?”*
- 9 They grumbled that 2 things could have been done with the fragrant oil. What were they?  
– *1) it might have been sold for much and 2) given to the poor*
- 10a When did Jesus then talk to the disciples?  
– *when He was aware of it*
- 10b Jesus asked, “Why do you \_\_\_\_\_ the woman?”  
– *trouble*
- 10c What did Jesus say she had done for Him?  
– *a good work*
- 11a Who did Jesus say they had with them always?  
– *the poor*
- 11b But who would they not have always?  
– *“Me” (Jesus)*
- 12 In pouring the fragrant oil on Jesus’ body, what did the woman do it for?  
– *“My burial”*
- 13 Jesus told the disciples that wherever the gospel is preached in the whole world, what would also be told?  
– *“what this woman has done will also be told as a memorial to her.”*

- 14 Which one of the twelve went to the chief priests?  
– *Judas Iscariot*
- 15a What did Judas ask the chief priests?  
– *“What are you willing to give me if I deliver Him to you?”*
- 15b What did the chief priests count out to Judas?  
– *30 pieces of silver*
- 16 From that time on, what did Judas seek?  
– *opportunity to betray Jesus*
- 17a When did the disciples come to Jesus?  
– *on the first day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread*
- 17b What did the disciples ask Jesus on the first day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread?  
– *“Where do you want us to prepare for You to eat the Passover?”*
- 18a Who did Jesus send the disciples into the city to find?  
– *a certain man*
- 18b What did Jesus refer to Himself as?  
– *the Teacher*
- 18c Complete: “My \_\_\_\_\_ is at \_\_\_\_\_; I will keep the \_\_\_\_\_ at your \_\_\_\_\_ with My \_\_\_\_\_.”  
– *time, hand, Passover, house, disciples*
- 19 So what two things did the disciples do?  
– *1) they did as Jesus had directed them, and 2) prepared the Passover*
- 20 When evening had come, what did Jesus do?  
– *He sat down with the twelve*
- 21 As they were eating the Passover, what did Jesus say?  
– *“Assuredly, I say to you, one of you will betray Me.”*
- 22a How did the disciples feel?  
– *exceedingly sorrowful*
- 22b What did each disciple begin to say to Him?  
– *“Lord, is it I?”*
- 23 Who did Jesus say would betray Him?  
– *“He who dipped his hand with Me in the dish will betray Me.”*
- 24a How does the Son of Man go?  
– *just as it is written of Him*
- 24b But, He said, “woe to” whom?  
– *the man by which the Son of Man is betrayed*
- 24c “It would have been \_\_\_\_\_ for that man if he had \_\_\_\_\_.”  
– *good, not, been, born*
- 25a Who was betraying Jesus?  
– *Judas*
- 25b What did Judas say to Jesus?  
– *“Rabbi, is it I?”*
- 25c What was Jesus’ reply to Judas?  
– *“You have said it.”*
- 26 As they were eating, what 5 things did Jesus do?  
– *1) He “took bread, 2) blessed and 3) broke it, and 4) gave it to the disciples and 5) said, “Take, eat; this is My body.”*
- 27 Complete: “Then He took the \_\_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_ it to them, saying, ‘\_\_\_\_\_ from it, all of you.’”  
– *cup, gave thanks, gave, drink*

- 28 What did Jesus say the cup represented?  
– *“This is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.”*
- 29 Jesus told them that He would not drink of “this fruit of the vine” till when?  
– *“until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father’s kingdom”*
- 30 When did Jesus and the disciples go out to the Mount of Olives?  
– *When they had sung a hymn*
- 31a What did Jesus say all of them would be made to do that night?  
– *“stumble because of Me”*
- 31b Complete: “For it is written, ‘I will \_\_\_\_\_ the \_\_\_\_\_, And the \_\_\_\_\_ of the \_\_\_\_\_ will be \_\_\_\_\_.’”  
– *strike, Shepherd, sheep, flock, scattered*
- 32 After He would be raised, what would He do?  
– *“I will go before you to Galilee.”*
- 33 Peter told Jesus that “even if all are made to stumble because of You,” how would he respond?  
– *“I will never be made to stumble.”*
- 34 Jesus told Peter exactly what day and time, how many times, he would deny Him. Name them.  
– *1) this night, 2) before the rooster crows, 3) three times*
- 35a Peter said, “Even if I have to \_\_\_\_\_ with You, I will \_\_\_\_\_ You!”  
– *die, not, deny*
- 35b What did all the other disciples do when Peter said he would die before betraying Jesus?  
– *“and so said all the disciples”*
- 36a Jesus came with the disciples to what place?  
– *a place called Gethsemane*
- 36b What did Jesus tell the disciples to do?  
– *“Sit here while I go and pray over there.”*
- 37a Who did Jesus take with Him?  
– *Peter and the two sons of Zebedee*
- 37b How did Jesus begin to feel?  
– *sorrowful and deeply distressed*
- 38 “My \_\_\_\_\_ is exceedingly \_\_\_\_\_, even to \_\_\_\_\_. Stay \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ with Me.”  
– *Soul, sorrowful, death, here, watch*
- 39a What 3 things did Jesus do after speaking to the three disciples?  
– *1) He went a little farther 2) fell on His face, 3) and prayed*
- 39b What did Jesus say in His first prayer?  
– *“O My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from me, nevertheless, not as I will, but as You will.”*
- 40a Then Jesus came back to the three disciples, what did He find them doing?  
– *sleeping*
- 40b What did Jesus say to Peter? “\_\_\_\_\_! Could you not \_\_\_\_\_ with me one \_\_\_\_\_?”  
– *what, watch, hour*
- 41a What did Jesus tell Peter to do?  
– *watch and pray*
- 41b Why did Jesus tell Peter to watch and pray?  
– *“Lest you fall into temptation”*
- 41c What did Jesus say is indeed willing and what is weak?  
– *the spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak*

- 42a After talking to the disciples, what did Jesus do for the second time?  
– *went away and prayed*
- 42b What did Jesus say in His second prayer?  
– *“O My Father, if this cup cannot pass away from me, unless I drink it, Your will be done.”*
- 43a When Jesus came back to the disciples the second time how did He find them?  
– *they were asleep again*
- 43b Why were they sleeping again?  
– *their eyes were heavy*
- 44 What did Jesus do for the third time and what was His third prayer? “So He \_\_\_\_\_ them, went \_\_\_\_\_ again, and \_\_\_\_\_ the third time, saying the \_\_\_\_\_ words.”  
– *left, away, prayed, same*
- 45a When Jesus came to His disciples the third time what did He ask them?  
– *“Are you still sleeping and resting?”*
- 45b What did Jesus tell the disciples was at hand?  
– *The hour*
- 45c What did Jesus say was happening to the Son of Man?  
– *He is being betrayed into the hands of sinners*
- 46 Complete: “\_\_\_\_\_, let us be \_\_\_\_\_. See, my \_\_\_\_\_ is at hand.”  
– *Rise, going, betrayer*
- 47a While Jesus was still speaking, who came?  
– *Judas, one of the twelve*
- 47b Who was with Judas?  
– *a great multitude with swords and clubs*
- 47c Who did the multitude come from?  
– *the chief priests and elders of the people*
- 48 What sign had Jesus betrayer given to the people with him?  
– *“Whomever I kiss, He is the one. Seize Him.”*
- 49 Complete: “\_\_\_\_\_ he went up to Jesus and said, \_\_\_\_\_ ! And \_\_\_\_\_ Him.”  
– *immediately, greetings, Rabbi, kissed*
- 50a What did Jesus ask Judas?  
– *“Friend, why have you come?”*
- 50b Then what 3 things did the multitude do?  
– *1) they came, 2) laid hands on Jesus, 3) and took Him*
- 51 Suddenly one of those who were with Jesus did what 4 things?  
– *1) he stretched out his hand, 2) drew his sword, 3) struck the servant of the High Priest, and 4) cut off his ear*
- 52a What did Jesus tell Peter to do?  
– *“Put your sword in its place”*
- 52b Why did Jesus tell Peter to put his sword in its place?  
– *“For all who take the sword will perish by the sword”*
- 53 How many legions of angels could Jesus be provided with if He prayed to His Father?  
– *twelve*
- 54 “How then could the \_\_\_\_\_ be \_\_\_\_\_ that it must happen \_\_\_\_\_?”  
– *scriptures, fulfilled, thus*
- 55a When did Jesus speak to the multitudes?  
– *in that hour*

- 55b Jesus asked them if they had come out with swords and clubs as if they were going against who?  
– *a robber*
- 55c “I sat \_\_\_\_\_ with you teaching in the \_\_\_\_\_ and you did not \_\_\_\_\_ me.”  
– *daily, temple, seize*
- 56a According to Jesus, why was His arrest done in the manner that it was since they could have taken Him any time at the temple?  
– *“...that the Scriptures of the prophets might be fulfilled”*
- 56b True or false. Following the arrest of Jesus, His disciples all forsook Him.  
– *true*
- 56c What did His disciples physically do when the arrest of Jesus was accomplished?  
– *they forsook Him and fled*
- 57a Who lead Jesus away from the place of His arrest?  
– *those who had laid hold of Jesus*
- 57b To whom did they take Jesus first after His arrest?  
– *to Caiaphas*
- 57c What position did Caiaphas hold that they would take Jesus there?  
– *High Priest*
- 57d Who was assembled at Caiaphas’ place?  
– *the scribes and elders*
- 58a After forsaking Jesus and fleeing, which disciple followed Him?  
– *Peter*
- 58b True or False. Peter followed Jesus closely after the arrest so as to be a strength to Him  
– *false, he followed at a distance*
- 58c Where did Peter follow Jesus to?  
– *the High Priest’s courtyard*
- 58d When Peter got to the high priest’s courtyard, what 2 things did he do?  
– *1) went in and 2) sat*
- 58e Who did Peter sit with in the courtyard of the High Priest?  
– *the servants*
- 58f What was his purpose for going in and sitting in the courtyard?  
– *to see “the end”*
- 59a What kind of testimony was sought against Jesus?  
– *false*
- 59b Who sought false testimony against Jesus? List 3.  
– *1) chief priests 2) elders 3) all the council*
- 59c What was their purpose in seeking false testimony?  
– *to put Jesus to death*
- 60a True or False. The chief priests, scribes and all the council found false testimony against Jesus quickly.  
– *false*
- 60b True or False. The chief priests, scribes and all the council found false witnesses against Jesus.  
– *true*

- 60c They “at last” found how many false witnesses to come forward?  
– *two*
- 61a What did the false witnesses say? “This \_\_\_\_\_ said, ‘I am able to \_\_\_\_\_ the temple of \_\_\_\_\_ and to build it in \_\_\_\_\_ days.’”  
– *Fellow, destroy, God, three*
- 62a Upon hearing the testimony, who arose and spoke to Jesus?  
– *the High Priest*
- 62b True or false. The High Priest made two statements to Jesus at this time.  
– *false (two questions)*
- 62c Caiaphas asked Jesus, “Do You answer \_\_\_\_\_?”  
– *nothing*
- 62d Then Caiaphas asked Jesus, “What is it these men \_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_ You?”  
– *testify, against*
- 63a True or false. Jesus answered Caiaphas’ questions.  
– *false, He kept silent*
- 63b Caiaphas, in the face of Jesus’ silence, did what?  
– *put Jesus under oath*
- 63c Caiaphas claimed the oath was by whose power?  
– *the living God*
- 63d What did Caiaphas demand that Jesus tell them?  
– *“ . . .if You are the Christ, the Son of God”*
- 64a True or false. When Caiaphas demanded to know if Jesus was the Christ, Jesus continued to remain silent.  
– *false*
- 64b Jesus stated to Caiaphas that the answer was as who had said?  
– *Caiaphas*
- 64c Jesus further stated, “Nevertheless, I say to you, \_\_\_\_\_ you will see the \_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_ sitting at the \_\_\_\_\_ hand of the \_\_\_\_\_, and coming on the \_\_\_\_\_ of heaven.”  
– *hereafter, Son, of, Man, right, Power, clouds*
- 65a When the High Priest heard Jesus’ answer, what did he do?  
– *he tore his clothes*
- 65b Caiaphas proclaimed that Jesus had spoken what?  
– *blasphemy*
- 65c With Jesus’ statement, Caiaphas asked if there was a further need of what?  
– *witnesses*
- 65d Why was there no further need for witnesses?  
– *“ . . .you have heard His blasphemy!”*
- 66a At this point, what did Caiaphas ask the council?  
– *“What do you think?”*
- 66b What was the council’s answer to Caiaphas?  
– *“He is deserving of death”*
- 67a After decreeing that Jesus was deserving of death, what 3 things did they then do to Him?  
– *1) spat in His face, 2) beat Him, 3) struck Him with the palms of their hands*

- 68a What did they want Jesus to do while they abused Him?  
– *prophesy*
- 68b What did they want Him to prophesy?  
– *who had struck Him*
- 69a While this was going on inside, who was sitting outside?  
– *Peter*
- 69b Where was Peter sitting?  
– *in the courtyard*
- 69c Who came and talked to Peter in the courtyard?  
– *a servant girl*
- 69d What did she state to Peter?  
– *that he had also been with Jesus*
- 69e Where did the servant girl state that Jesus was from?  
– *Galilee*
- 70a True or false. Peter denied he had been with Jesus in the hearing of the servant girl only.  
– *false, he denied it before them all*
- 70b Peter denied knowing Jesus the first time stating, “I \_\_\_\_\_ know what you \_\_\_\_\_.”  
– *do, not, are, saying*
- 71a After the first denial of Jesus, Peter went out to where?  
– *the gateway*
- 71b Who saw him there?  
– *another girl*
- 71c True or false. This second girl did not speak to Peter, but only to the others there.  
– *true*
- 71d What did she state to the others?  
– *that “this fellow” had also been with Jesus*
- 72e Where did she state Jesus was from?  
– *Nazareth*
- 72a What did Peter use to accompany his second denial?  
– *an oath*
- 72b Peter denied Jesus the second time with the words, “I do \_\_\_\_\_ the \_\_\_\_\_!”  
– *not, know, Man*
- 73a When, as compared to the second denial, did the third denial take place?  
– *a little later*
- 73b Who spoke to Peter the statement which provoked his third denial?  
– *those who stood by*
- 73c Why did they say they believed that Peter was also “one of them”?  
– *his speech betrayed him*
- 74a What was Peter’s reaction to this third statement by people in the courtyard?  
– *he began to curse and swear*

74b True or false. Peter denied Jesus the third time with the same statement that he had used for his second denial.

– *true*

74c What was the statement Peter used for his second and third denials?

– *“I do not know the Man!”*

74d What happened immediately after Peter made his third denial?

– *a rooster crowed*

75a When Peter heard the rooster crow, what did he remember?

– *what Jesus had said to him*

75b Before His arrest, Jesus had told Peter, “\_\_\_\_\_ the rooster crows, you will \_\_\_\_\_ Me \_\_\_\_\_ times.”

– *before, deny, three*

75c True or False. Upon hearing the rooster crow, Peter stayed in the courtyard.

– *false, he went out*

75d What did Peter do after he “went out”?

– *he wept bitterly*
